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apple puree - for later

This year is a strange one, and many of us don't have much fruit this year. A rainy spring meant bees didn't do their usual job very well. With our meagre apple harvest, we are making amongst the usual delights of this season, apple puree to freeze for a later, less bountiful date. I use this very easy recipe.

**apples, peeled, cored and chopped
a little water
sugar to taste**

Put the apples in a pan with a little water to help them cook. Cover and cook very gently until the apples begin to break up, about 20 minutes usually. Mash them with a fork or potato masher and sweeten to taste with sugar.
